At the time of the writing of our last prayer letter, Robert was able to lead an adult couple to the Lord after they began attending church as a result of door-knocking. Just in the last two weeks, three young preteen boys made professions of faith in response to the message delivered during a twice-per-month youth rally. Robert was able to pray with two of the boys while Pastor Bill Bramblet prayed with a third. We never imagined that God would allow us to take part in such things so quickly after arriving here on the mission field.

The children come from varied

circumstances. Some are native Australian (aboriginal). Many come from appalling family situations. We feel that there is a potential with each young person to be used of God to make an impact on their culture.

Fellowship is truly a multicultural assembly of believers and reflects the culture at large here. There are people from Scotland, America, Australia, Burma, Sri Lanka, England, China and Indonesia. Our desire is to see a greater impact among native (non-aboriginal) Australians. Our greatest obstacle is the fact that Australia is a very wealthy and affluent society. Most typical Australians do not see a need for dependence upon God because they do so well for themselves.

Please pray with us that there will be a softening of the hearts of people here to the Good News of the gospel.

Finally, we will be meeting with two families in Burpengary to explore the possibility of a new church plant. We are scheduled to meet with them after Christmas.
