We have seen God do some great things over the last two months. First and foremost, Robert was able to lead a woman to the Lord on her doorstep during the weekly door-knocking campaign in the area of Stafford. Her name is Lauren and she was a wiccan (witch) for nearly twenty years. Her heart had been softened toward the Lord recently but she had never trusted Christ as Saviour. In fact, she had been attending a local non-denominational church and was scheduled to be baptized, although her pastor had just "assumed" she was saved. This kind of soft religion, as well as a social gospel where people are never really confronted with the truth of God's Word are among the greatest hindrances to the work here. We are encouraging Lauren to attend a local Bible-believing, Bible-preaching Baptist church but she still has not made the decision to do so. We are encouraged that she is concerned about the salvation of her husband and children. We will continue to work with her when we can.

Furthermore, we feel a greater leading of the Lord in the area where we will begin a church plant. The city is Nambour and it is just over an hour north of the city of Brisbane. Nambour does not have a Baptist church and is a fairly populous city. When Robert returns from a short furlough in

December of next year, then we will move to that area and begin in earnest to start a new independent Baptist Church there.

Robert will be leaving for the States in June of 2016 to report to our churches. The furlough will only be 6 months long and will not be for the purpose of raising new support. Please consider having him in your church sometime during the months of June to November of 2016. Otherwise, we will be mailing a dvd to our supporting churches which will take the place of a personal visit.

We mentioned Ray and Margaret in our last prayer letter. We have left them in the hands of Pastor Andrew Van Komen, who is a local Aussie pastor here. Currently, they still have not come to a decision to trust Christ but pastor Van Komen continues to work with them.
