We have to be careful not to get too far ahead of ourselves because we are still just over one year away from fulfilling our commitment with Fellowship Baptist Church, our sponsoring church. However, we are trying to "redeem the time" by doing as much leg work as possible in order to prepare for our first full term once Robert returns from a

short furlough in 2016.

To all the churches who receive our prayer letter by regular mail, if you did not receive our December-January 2015 prayer letter, please accept our apologies as Jennifer's dad was handling all our stateside mailouts. He passed away in February. Thankfully, Jennifer was able to make it back to Texas in time to see him before he went home to be with the Lord. We are grateful for all who expressed condolences during this most difficult time.

Robert and Pastor Bill Bramblet continue to knock on doors every week sharing the Good News through tracts and verbal witnessing. We have seen nominal growth in Fellowship Baptist Church here in Stafford, in part through word-of-mouth and through the handing out of tracts. The church is now considering finding another property as the seating capacity on most Sunday mornings has exceeded 80%! What a wonderful problem to have!

Our greatest concern continues to be reaching the parents of the youth who come to the Friday night youth meetings, as well as the youth themselves. Please continue to pray with us that we might reach these parents while there is still time.
