We have a vision. Our vision is clear and simple: Aussies reaching Aussies. One might wonder where the role of the missionary comes in. We have specific goals, and the primary goal is to build independent, fundamental, Bible-believing and preaching Baptist churches that are indigenous. Pastoring a church in Australia is not one of our goals, although I will have to assume certain pastoral duties while the church is in the process of becoming established. These churches will be pastored by Australian men whom God will raise up through our soul-winning and discipling efforts in Australia. We believe no person can reach an Aussie better than an Aussie and the Lord is going to uniquely equip us to make this happen.

In the meantime, we will continue raising our support through deputation until we can make it to the field of Brisbane. Brisbane is a city of over two-million where only a handful of true New Testament churches exist.

We have now presented our field in fifty-two churches. We have presented in the states of Texas, Ohio, Michigan, New York, Missouri, Kansas, and Oklahoma. We have traveled almost thirty-thousand miles. We have raised twenty percent of our needed support. There have been times of plenty and there have been times where we have waited on the Lord to supply our needs. He has not failed us yet! All of our experiences have been uplifting and encouraging.

While on appointment in Portsmouth, OH, we had the opportunity to share the Good News with an illegal Mexican immigrant. We realized that people who are at a point of great need are most open to the Gospel. Australians are also in great need even though they are one of the wealthiest nations in the world. Pray with us that as God transitions us to the field He will allow us to meet them at their greatest need which is assurance and hope in the midst of financial crisis.
